

# Redland Primary School Home-School Agreement

## **The School will:**

- a) Encourage our children to do their best at all times
- b) Encourage our children to be confident, happy, well behaved and develop positive self esteem
- c) Inform Parents of the children's progress at regular meetings
- d) Give Parents information and guidance on ways they can help their child make progress, for example, by keeping Parents informed about what the children are learning, giving advice on activities that can be undertaken at home and other homework
- e) Inform Parents if school has any concerns about the child's attendance or if they do not have the appropriate equipment (e.g. P.E. kit), so that they cannot take part in lessons effectively
- f) Keep Parents informed about life at school through regular newsletters (now available via e-mail), class assemblies, open days etc.
- g) Work with Parents positively to help our children enjoy coming to school and become an active and accomplished lifelong learner

## **Parents and Guardians will:**

- 1) Having read and signed the Behaviour Contract letter, work with the school to support this
- 2) Give the child support and encouragement in the activities undertaken at school when homework is set and help the child complete the activities to the best of their ability
- 3) Make sure that the child comes to school regularly, is on time and avoid taking the child out of school unnecessarily or without prior agreement
- 4) Inform school if the child is unwell, by telephone (or in person if dropping off other children) on the first day of absence. Confirm this in writing when your child returns so we can update our records.

- 5) Provide the child with the appropriate kit to take part in lessons for P.E. games and swimming
- 6) Inform the class teacher or Head teacher if there is a worry at home that may affect the child's progress- confidentiality is assured
- 7) Work with the school in partnership, for example by attending parents evenings so that the school and parents can work together to enable the child to enjoy school and make progress

**Together we will:**

- Tackle any special educational needs
- Encourage the children to keep the school's 'Golden Rules'
- Support the child's learning to help them achieve their best
- Ensure a smooth transition between the key stages and on into secondary education
