Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

Please be aware that as of now, any child riding a scooter in the playground will be told that they can no longer bring it onto the school grounds.

All children have been repeatedly told not to ride their scooters in the playground. I spoke to several children last week who were 'scooting' out of the playground and last night one of our younger children was injured after colliding with a 'scooter rider'. **Children MUST walk their scooters in and out of school.**

Can I also draw your attention to the fact that we have had two scooter thefts recently. One overnight and one during the day. Please make sure that all scooters are taken home at the end of the school day. We are thinking about installing CCTV or moving the scooter rack as a way of addressing this problem but the night-time problem would be solved if there were no scooters to steal.

I trust you understand the reason behind this letter and that you will ensure that no scooter riding takes place in the school grounds. I also ask that scooters are away from the school entrances before being ridden home. Thank you ...
