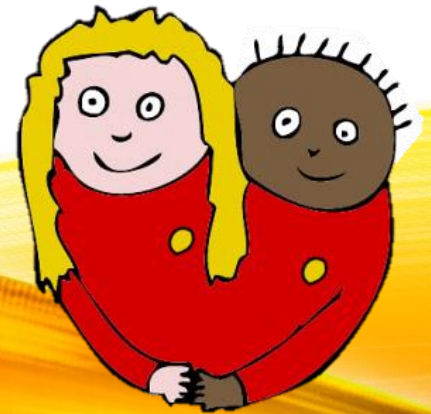


IMPORTANT CHANGES TO OUR SCHOOL RULES

BUBBLES!

- You are now in class bubbles. This means that you can mix with your class but you cannot mix with other bubbles.
- At play time and lunch time, you will be with your class bubble. There will not be another bubble in the same area as you.
- You may start and finish school at a different time to other bubbles.
- You must not touch other people in your bubble.
- You have probably heard of 'social distancing'. We need to 'social distance' where we can.
- Think of it as a protective force-field you have around you, like you are a superhero!

IN THE CLASSROOM

- Your classroom will belong to your class bubble and no other bubble will use it.
- Your classroom might look different to when you were last in school.
- Most desks will be facing forward in rows.
- You will need to stay at your table or in your designated space.
- Some furniture will have been removed to make more space.
- You will have your own set of stationery.
- You will need to ask if you need to move around the classroom and use other resources.
- Windows and doors will be open a lot more than usual, even when it's cold!

BELONGINGS

- You may bring in your coat, water bottle and lunch box. Year 6 children are allowed to bring in a backpack.
- You must not bring in a pencil case. Stationery sets will be provided for you.
- You will be able to take reading books home.
- There is no snack at the moment so you can bring this in from home.

ONE WAY OR WALK LEFT

There are floor markings around the school to show you which direction to walk. You will need to keep left, especially if you are having to walk past someone.
