Term 1 2023-24

Redland School

As readers...

We will be reading the online text 'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone' by J K Rowling as a class. We will also be looking at examples of letters and a variety of examples of description relating to our class text and topic.

Reading lessons will focus on a range of different reading skills, including: decoding, skimming and scanning as well as other comprehension skills.

As writers...

We will be checking our understanding of punctuation and sentence types. We will recap the use of adjectives to write descriptively. We will be writing letters of both formal and informal nature and then making links to our class story and topic when letters and descriptions.

As linguists...

We will be looking at greetings and forms of address; asking and answering simple questions; days of the week and recognising keywords and phrases.

As mathematicians...

We will work on developing our place value and number understanding. There will be a big focus on the use of manipulatives such as ten frames and base 10 (hundreds, tens and ones) to support our understanding. We will then develop this further by learning methods for addition and subtraction. In addition, we will be looking at real life mathematics by using lots of practical apparatus, such as money.

'Redland is 50!'

As Redland is celebrating its 50th birthday this year, our focus will be the school and how things have changed in the time it's been open. Each class pair is focussing on one of the decades that it has been open for. Puffins and Nightingales are learning about the 1990s!

We will be using history skills throughout the topic to investigate the 90s, looking at:

School life, popular culture, news events and everyday life.

we will be looking at 'Being Me in My World' and the year ahead, including being a global citizen.

As active individuals (PE)...

Both Puffins and Nightingales will be having football lessons with Mr Murphy from Up and Under. In addition, we will be doing dance with Mr Mitchell.
