As readers...

This term, our whole class reading text is 'Agents of the Wild: Operation honeyhunt' by Jennifer Bell & Alice Lickens. We will be using this in our reading lessons alongside other short texts to support comprehension activities. Reading lessons will focus on a range of different reading skills, including: decoding, skimming and scanning as well as other comprehension skills. Please encourage your child's love of reading by reading regularly at home and recording this in their reading records.

As writers...

We will be learning how to use fronted adverbials in our writing and commas to signify these as well as using commas in a list. We will also be using apostrophes for contracted forms and the possessive (singular). We will be writing persuasive travel brochures, linked to our topic.

As linguists...

We will be revisiting parts of the body and learning clothes words. We will also be developing our listening skills and use problem-solving strategies to translate and create simple sentences containing familiar topic vocabulary and grammar.

As mathematicians...

We will be learning all about multiplication and division. We will be looking at formal ways to record and solve multiplication and division problems, as well as representing related problems practically and pictorially.

We will also be spending time learning known facts related to multiplication and division.
