As readers...

This term, our whole class reading text is 'Agents of the Wild: Operation honeyhunt' by Jennifer Bell & Alice Lickens. We will be using this in our reading lessons alongside other short texts to support comprehension activities. Reading lessons will focus on a range of different reading skills, including: decoding, skimming and scanning as well as other comprehension skills. Please encourage your child's love of reading by reading regularly at home and recording this in their reading records.

As writers...

We will be exploring rhyming poetry and identifying and creating rhyming words and patterns. We will then be creating our own rhyming poetry inspired by Julia Donaldson and performing them.

As linguists... We will be continuing sentence-level work to become confident at using masculine, feminine and plural adjective agreement. Recognise and record keywords and phrases from a spoken text, practise reading out loud to learn simple pronunciation rules. Listen to story of "Max & Mathilde en ville" and practise reading as a class.

As mathematicians...

We will be finishing our work on multiplication and division. We will be looking at formal ways to record and solve multiplication and division problems, as well as representing related problems practically and pictorially.

We will also be spending time learning about measurement: mass and capacity.

This term we will be exploring how to design and construct our own kites. We will start by exploring the different parts and functions of kites and test the most effective shapes. We will select the most appropriate materials to use by considering what will be most durable and light-weight. After creating a design, we will construct, test and evaluate our kites.
