Reading lessons will focus on a range of different reading skills, including: decoding, skimming and scanning as well as other comprehension skills.

Please encourage your child's love of reading by reading regularly at home and recording this in their reading records.


As writers...

We will be using our class text to inspire our own retellings of a traditional tale with a grammar focus on using direct speech.

As linguists... We will be learning about different icecream flavours. We'll recognise the relationship between written words and pronunciation; notice rhythm and rhyme in words. We will use simple phrases in a role-play situation and express likes and dislikes for certain ice-cream flavours.

As mathematicians...

We will be starting our learning on fractions this term. We will be comparing and ordering unit and non-unit fractions, using fractions on a number line and finding equivalent fractions on a number line. We will then move on to adding and subtracting fractions as well as finding fractions of a set of objects.



This term we will be exploring the life of the Ancient Egyptians. We will use our geographical skills to locate Egypt on a map and learn what life was like in Ancient Egypt. We will also explore what mumnification is, learn about the great Egyptian pharaoh Tutankhamun and consider how to write like an Egyptian, in hieroglyphics.
