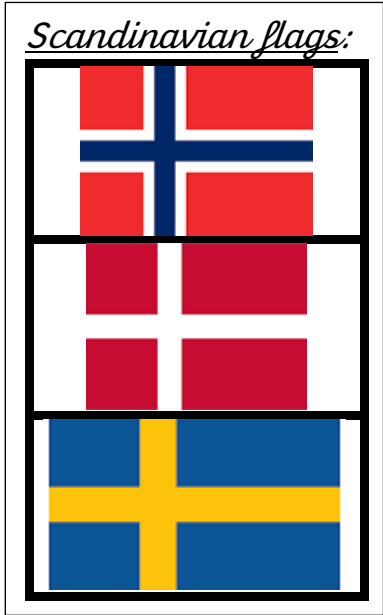
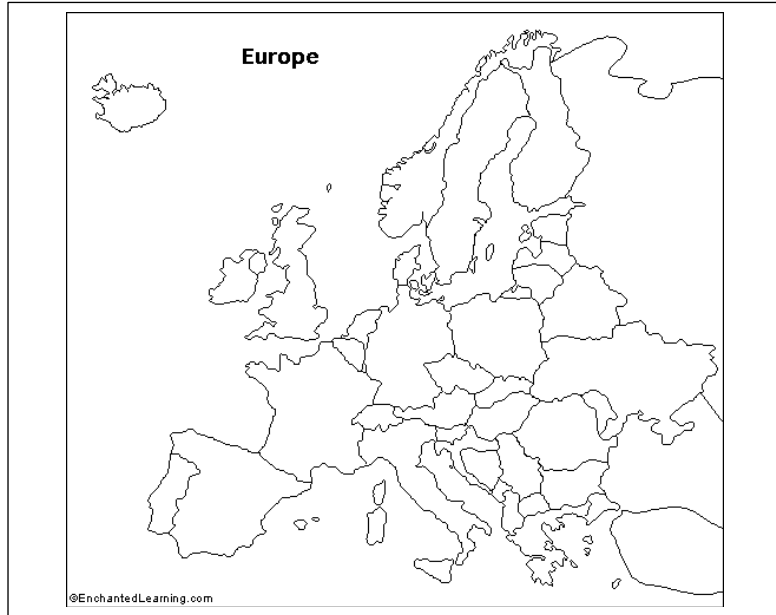


Our European neighbours: Scandinavia
