"My favourite bit was the 360° film about Stonehenge in the exhibition centre. The actual monument was amazing!" **Happie T**

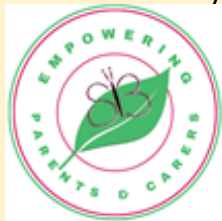
Parent Session with Sarah Bentley
