#### **School Uniform**

Here are a few reminders about school uniform expectations:

Nail varnish is not allowed in school. Earrings are permitted but must only be studs. All other jewellery items are not permitted in school, except for wrist watches.

We ask that children with long hair have their hair tied up for school.

Black shoes are to be worn with the school uniform. Trainers can be worn as part of the PE kit or for outdoor learning sessions only.
